

CFL Boat Use Training Guide

WI Boater Safety Certification if born after 1/1/89

Know the reservation system and checking out boats

Boat stewardship. Clean boat and clean up after yourself

Slack channel for safety. Let someone know you are going out

Communicate issues with Aaron

Always check weather/wind

Need life jackets and 1 throwable per boat. Must wear life jackets if water is under 50 degrees F

Make sure fire extinguisher is on board

Gas and gas policy. Replace empty if you run out. Leave empty in boat slip

Use the bilge in the boat if water accumulates

Each boat has a garage door opener. There is also one on the wall

How to tie up boat. OXO. Make sure it won't hit garage door.

Wear safety cord and there are emergency contacts and troubleshooting cards in boats

Trim up heading out and on the way back in. Shallow

No wake <200 feet from shoreline

Driving

- Do everything gradually, take your time

- Communicate your moves to your passengers

- Give right away to everyone most importantly non-motorized vessels

- When going from forward to reverse or vice versa make sure to stop in neutral (don't grind gears)

- Gradual turns, don't yank!

- Practice
